Student or staff has symptoms compatible with COVID-19 but has NO KNOWN contact with a confirmed or presumptive case of COVID-19 the prior 14 days	<b>Suspect case</b>	Advise follow up with provider and COVID-19 testing.	<b><u>10-day isolation</u></b>  Individuals with COVID-19 compatible illness must remain home full 10-day isolation if not tested.	10 days from the date of onset if not test was performed.  OR Improving symptoms  AND 24 hours fever free without the use of anti-fever medication  AND Negative COVID-19 test  AND An alternative diagnosis from a clinician	Individuals referred to testing who subsequently test positive become <i>confirmed cases</i> .
Student or staff has been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 the past 14 days, but it is not symptomatic.	<b>Case Contact</b>	Monitor for symptoms of COVID-19, follow up with provider and obtain test if symptoms develop.	<b><u>14-day quarantine</u></b>  14 days from the <u>last exposure**</u>	14 days from the last exposure  **If the contact is continuous, such as in household cases, the 14-day quarantine may begin AFTER the cases 10-day isolation ended. For a maximum potential of 24 days.	Fully vaccinated contacts will not have to quarantine IF it has been two weeks since the final, dose of vaccine. Fully vaccinated contacts MUST symptoms screen for 14 days. Close contacts previously infected with COVID-19 will not have to quarantine if it has been less than 90 days since their completed isolation period.
