Dear Elementary School Parents;

In past years, our lunch rooms have used a card system for our kids to swipe at breakfast and or lunch. The kids put these cards in their mouths, on their trays with sauce, drop them on the floor, etc. We will be moving to a pin pad entry to keep your kids and our staff as safe as possible as we start our new school year.

Your student will need to memorize their student ID number and enter it on the pin pad after using hand sanitizer/washing their hands. This will be a little harder for our youngest kids, so for the first few weeks we will be providing each student with a disposable bracelet that has their ID number on it. Our staff will help them through this process. We ask that you help your child/children to memorize their number at home. The ID number is six digits and will stay with them until they graduate Highschool.

We are one of the last districts to advance to this system for our elementary school kids. This is the process our Middle and Highschool kids are already doing. With your help at home, I believe we will navigate through this quickly and easily.
